Did You Know?

Architectural Review Committee (ARC): If you are planning to remodel your condo, please remember many things need to be approved **IN ADVANCE**. Architectural Review approval forms

must be submitted before the work begins and can be found on the Timber Creek Golf Website and Town Square.

The ARC is currently working on a Hurricane Protection Policy. This is being done to comply with new language in State statute 718.113 and House Bill 1021. This includes code compliant windows, doors, impact glass, shutters and other code compliant hurricane protection products. This Association will not require owners to add hurricane protection products. We will develop guidelines as to what products would be acceptable and owner responsibilities for installation and maintenance IF owners request approval for addition to their individual condo.
